- Thousands of Idaho students will get excited about science and engineering this week at a series of Treasure Valley expos co-sponsored by Idaho National Laboratory. Students of all ages will visit expos focused on science, technology, engineering and math. The expos start Monday and culminate with Saturday's Discover Engineering event at Boise State University.
- Idaho's governor will help INL leaders celebrate new technology at INL's 14th Annual Honors Banquet Friday. The commercialization of technology created in Idaho is a key part of Gov. C.L. "Butch" Otter's Project 60 initiative to grow the state economy. Friday's banquet will celebrate INL researchers who have patented new technology.
- One honoree helped develop technology that is now turning greasy wastewater from municipal water treatment plants into the highest-quality biodiesel. BioFuelBox licensed the technology and has been producing biodiesel in American Falls since last year.
