

## Idaho National Laboratory Dual Credit Scholarship Program

The Idaho National Laboratory (INL) is committed to increasing the number of students pursuing science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) related careers. Our mission is to maximize the impact the INL has on enhancing STEM education in Idaho as we seek to prepare and inspire learners of all ages to become STEM literate and to contribute to the development of solutions for the energy, environmental, and security challenges in our world.

Idaho high school students earn technical certificates or college credits in STEM courses. The Idaho National Laboratory Dual Credit Scholarship Program provides high school students with funding to cover the fees and materials associated with college-level, university-level, or technical certificated courses.

INL Education Programs has annual reporting requirements. Schools or Districts who receive 2011 Dual Credit Scholarship Grants are required to submit an evaluation report describing the outcomes/results of the grant by June 10, 2011. The evaluation report form will be attached to the award notice.
