

Cooperative emergency policies

INL Cooperative Emergency Agreements

Idaho National Laboratory has five types of cooperative emergency agreements that specifically apply to wildland fire response. These are:

Cooperative Fire Protection Agreements for Mutual Aid -- Snake River District Bureau of Land Management and the Department of Agriculture Caribou/Targhee National Forests

Interagency Agreements --National Park Service

Reciprocal Fire Fighting Assistance Agreements -- the cities Blackfoot, Pocatello, Arco, Rexburg, American Falls, Chubbuck and Rigby

Cooperative Fire Control Agreements for Mutual Fire Aid -- U.S. Department of Agriculture Salmon-Challis National Forest

Memorandum of Understanding -- Idaho Falls Fire Department

Equipment and personnel are only used in areas of their specialty and expertise. No personnel are required or expected to respond to an incident for which they are not trained.

INL may requests land-based or air attack capabilities maintained by several of these agencies.
